Physical

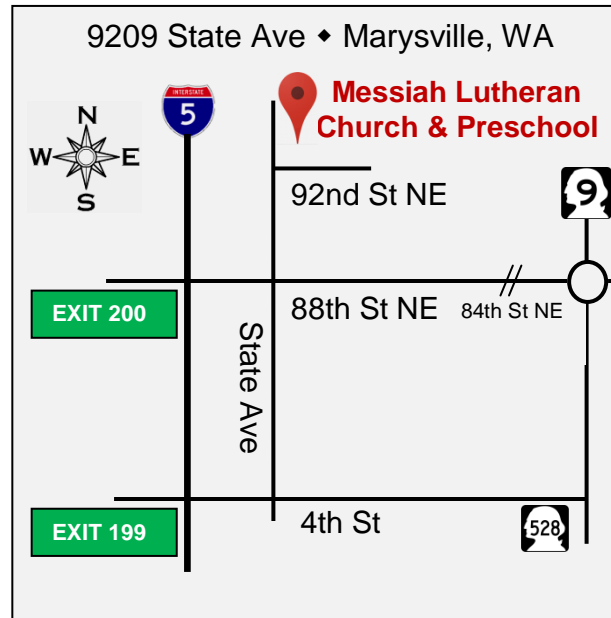
- Large/small muscle coordination

Registration is complete and your child's enrollment secured when registration forms and registration fee have been received. An annual registration fee of **\$75** is paid upon

registration. This fee will ensure a place for your child and help supply needed materials. All program registration fees are non-refundable. Orientation and back-to-school information will be mailed the first week of August to all enrolled families.

Acceptance into the programs is based on space availability.

TUITION

Tuition for Messiah's Little Lamb's Preschool is based on a nine-month school year and collected monthly.

The tuition is to be paid the first school day of each consecutive month Sept.-May and is not refundable. Two-week notice required for withdrawals.

Messiah Lutheran Preschool is operated under the guidance and direction of the congregation's Preschool Board and is a ministry of Messiah Lutheran Church.

The curriculum used is developed and refined by our staff and professional educators in the Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod and other early childhood education resources.
